

Data Dictionary for Households

Field	Description
Community	Name of the community. 218 communities were identified for the purposes of the profiles.
number_families	Total number of families
%family_children_under18	% of the families having children under 18 years old
number_persons_household	Number of persons per household
number_persons_family	Number of persons per family
%moved_last_5yrs	% who moved during the last 5 years
%married_couple_family	% of households identifying as married couple family
%single_parent_family	% of households identifying as single parent family
%single_person	% of households identifying as single persons
%non_family	% of households identifying as non-family
%seniors_live_alone	% of people 65 and over, who live alone

Data notes:

1. Because the Census is conducted in two parts, a complete and a sample survey, it is possible to find two numbers, which should logically be the same, but which are slightly different. Also, due to the effects of rounding, percentages may not always add to exactly 100%.
2. No attempt was made to carry the accuracy of reported percentages beyond two decimal places (.01); therefore segments of the population making up less than 0.5% were generally reported as 0%.
3. Persons per household and persons per family for an area are averages for each component tract within the area unless values for the total area were presented in summary form.
4. Many of the 1980 neighborhood boundaries for the City of Pittsburgh neighborhoods had changed from their 1960 and 1970 boundaries. To derive 1970 values for neighborhoods, conversion formulas provided by the City of Pittsburgh's Dept. of Planning were used conversion formulas were not prepared by the City for areas, which were estimated to have changed by less than 5%. Separate conversion formulas were used for items that used people as a unit of measurement and those that used households or housing units as a unit measurement.
