

Community Facilities

The Communities Facility dataset is extracted from the *Community Profiles* reports, prepared by Pittsburgh's Department of City Planning in August 1974. These reports are divided into four sections: Population, Housing, Socio-Economic Characteristics, and Community Facilities. This data represents the final section of the *Community Profiles* reports, in which the Department of City Planning provides the following scope: "Community facilities which serve [the neighborhood] are not limited to those located within the confines of [the neighborhood]. Although there are many community facilities in the general vicinity, this list is limited to police and fire stations, public libraries, public schools, City of Pittsburgh recreational facilities (indoor and outdoor), major hospitals, and major colleges and universities."

neighborhood	Name of neighborhood, section of neighborhood, or grouping of neighborhoods assigned by the Department of City Planning in the <i>Community Profiles</i> reports. The dataset retains the names and groupings that the Department of City Planning used, even if the names are no longer commonly employed (e.g. Harden Hilltop).	General	South Oakland
facility name	Facility name listed by the Department of City Planning. Where the Department of City Planning grouped facilities together in a line (e.g. Fire Stations No. 43, 46, and 50), the data was separated so only one facility appears in a cell. The Department of City Planning included facilities that provide service to the neighborhood, in addition to those located in the neighborhood.	General	Schenley Park
facility subtype	Category for facility type. Categories are drawn report and include: police station, fire station, public library, public school, recreational facility, hospital, and college.	General	Recreational facility
